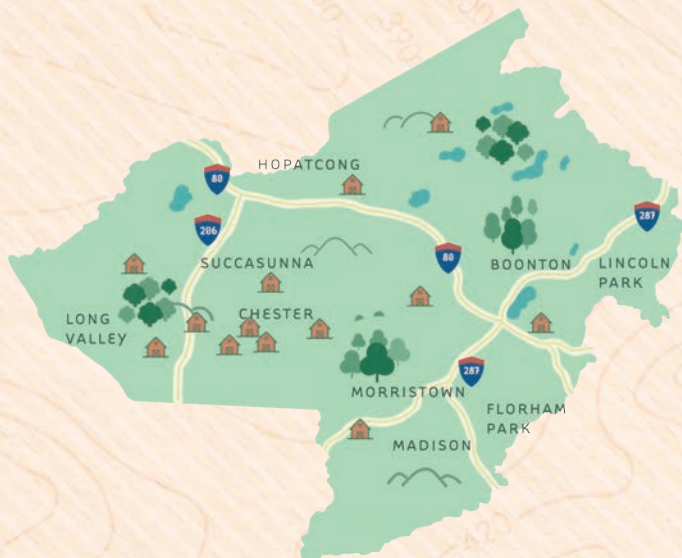

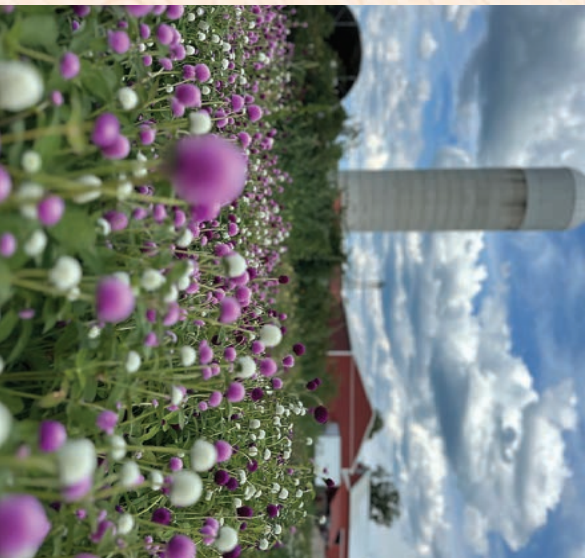

Morris County Farm Trail Passport Program Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN

The Morris County Farm Trail Passport Program ("Program") is sponsored by the Morris County Tourism Bureau ("Sponsor").

1. Eligibility

The Program is open to legal residents of the United States who are twenty-one (21) years of age or older at the time of entry. Employees, officers, directors, and agents of the Sponsor and participating farms, and their immediate family members and household members, are excluded from eligibility.

Void where prohibited by law.

2. Program Period

The Program operates on an annual basis. Participants may collect farm stamps throughout the Program year and may complete their Passport at their own pace. There is no time limit for completing a Passport.

To be eligible for the annual Grand Prize drawing for a given year, completed Passports must be received by the Sponsor and postmarked no later than December 31 of that year.

3. How to Participate

Participants may obtain a Morris County Farm Trail Passport and visit participating farms to collect stamps.

To receive a stamp:

- The participant must be physically present at the participating farm.
- The participant must present their own Passport.
- Only one stamp per participating farm may be collected.
- Purchases are not required to collect stamps.
- A valid receipt from a farm (proving physical presence) may be submitted in lieu of a stamp if a stamp was not available at the time of the visit.

Each participant must maintain and submit their own Passport. Passports may not be shared, transferred, combined, or completed on behalf of another individual.

4. Grand Prize Entry

A participant will receive one (1) entry into the annual Grand Prize drawing upon submission of a completed Passport containing all required farm stamps.

Completed Passports should be mailed to the Morris County Tourism Bureau at the address designated by the Sponsor, below.

Passports submitted on or before September 15 of the applicable Program year will receive one additional bonus entry, for a total of two (2) entries in the annual Grand Prize drawing.

5. Prize

One (1) Grand Prize winner will be selected annually.

The Grand Prize consists of a basket of farm products, merchandise, gift certificates, and other items provided by participating farms and partners with an approximate retail value ("ARV") of \$1,200.

The actual contents of the Grand Prize may vary from year to year. No substitution, transfer, or cash redemption of the prize is permitted except at the Sponsor's sole discretion.

The winner is responsible for any federal, state, or local taxes associated with acceptance or use of the prize.

Visit 5 or more farms to earn a special gift from the Morris County Farm Trail!

6. Winner Selection and Notification

An eligible winner will be selected in a random drawing from all eligible entries received for the applicable Program year.

The Sponsor will attempt to notify the selected winner using the contact information provided with the submitted Passport.

If a selected winner cannot be contacted, declines the prize, is found to be ineligible, or fails to respond within a reasonable time designated by the Sponsor, the Sponsor reserves the right to select an alternate winner.

The Sponsor's decisions regarding the Program and prize award are final and binding.

7. Consent to Communications

By submitting a Passport, participants consent to receive electronic communications from the Morris County Farm Trail and Morris County Tourism Bureau.

These communications may include:

- Notices regarding Passport submissions and Program administration;
- Newsletters;
- Surveys;
- Information about participating farms;
- Special offers, promotions, events, and other marketing communications.

Participants may opt out of promotional electronic communications at any time by following the unsubscribe instructions included in such communications.

Opting out of promotional communications will not affect administrative communications necessary for Program operation.

8. Publicity Release

Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of a prize constitutes the winner's consent for the Sponsor to use the winner's name, hometown, likeness, and photograph for promotional and publicity purposes in any media without additional compensation.

9. Limitation of Liability

By participating, entrants agree to release and hold harmless the Sponsor, participating farms, and their respective officers, directors, employees, volunteers, and agents from any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, or expenses arising from participation in the Program or acceptance, possession, or use of any prize.

The Sponsor is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, damaged, incomplete, illegible, or delayed Passport submissions.

10. Program Changes

The Sponsor reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the Program, alter Program dates, revise prize details, or amend these Official Rules at any time if necessary for administration of the Program or to comply with applicable law.

Official updates, including annual Grand Prize winner announcements, will be published on the Morris County Farm Trail website and social media channels.

11. Third-Party Websites

The Passport may reference websites and online resources operated by third parties. The Sponsor has not reviewed all such websites and is not responsible for the content, accuracy, privacy practices, or availability of any third-party website or service.

12. Governing Law

The Program and these Official Rules shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey, without regard to conflict of law principles.
